Volunteer Roles

Home Visiting Support

Home-Visiting Volunteers provide 1 to 1 support to families in their own home. They provide emotional and practical support once a week to parents, helping to improve the wellbeing of the whole family.

Telephone Support

Telephone and Virtual Support Volunteers provide emotional support through listening and talking to parents over the phone or via online video calls. This role offers flexibility to volunteers who may have more limited availability.

Group Support

Group Support Volunteers help set up and run activities at one of the group sessions we run. They help create a safe and nurturing environments for parents attending and can help signpost parents to other support services available.

Fundraising Support

Fundraising & Event Volunteers support Home-Start in Suffolk to raise money, either by supporting existing fundraising events or organising their own.

You'll receive a call back to discuss the different volunteering roles, provided with a brief overview about Home-Start and discuss the type of support you may be able to provide.

Complete an Application Form

You will receive an application form to complete and provide 2 references. Once completed we will arrange an informal interview over Zoom to get to know you and give you an opportunity to ask any questions.

Complete Training

You'll be invited to complete 5 x 3-hour online training sessions. Once completed, you will be matched with a family based on your availability.

Home-Visiting Volunteers will also need to attend an additional in-person session.
